

# DWI SCHOOL IN CHAVES COUNTY

## 2006 Schedule

Counseling Associates has had this Certified DWI School in operation since the early 1980's. It was first an eight-hour school, and in March of 1988, it became a twelve-hour school. Counseling Associates now offers the Spanish DWI School. The **English school will be on three Tuesday nights of each month.** The **Spanish school will be held on the three Thursday nights of every other month that follows the English School,** unless a Holiday or scheduled vacation should interfere.

The purpose of the DWI School is to reduce the number of repeat offenders. Statistics show that in New Mexico, DWI is a serious problem. Our hope is that DWI Students will change the drinking and driving behavior as a result of having the opportunity to raise their awareness in regard to the severity of the problem. If you were sent to the DWI School by the Magistrate Court in Roswell, you have 60 days from the original court date to complete the school. The fee for this school will be \$125.00. If you fail to complete in that 60 days then you will be referred back to the court and action will be taken by the court. It is to your advantage to complete within that time limit in order to be able to have your license reinstated and drive again. This school meets at Counseling Associates, Inc. at 109 W. Bland in Roswell. You can call 505.420.6077. The class will be held at 6:00pm till 10:00pm for three consecutive weeks. Should you miss one of these classes, you will have to start over the following month and pay the \$125.00 fee again. This school provides 12 hours of instruction. You are to complete this school in the month that you start the school. We expect you to sign-in at 5:45pm on each day that the class is to be held. The fee must be paid prior to 5:00pm the day before the first class is to start. Please be prompt and do not come to class with alcohol on your breath because you will not be allowed to stay, and the fee will not be refunded. I have a breath test in class to determine dismissal from the class.

There will be group discussion, lecture, films and you are expected to take part in all activities. You will need to complete all the assigned work given in your work book. This is required home work. This school will provide you with many options that can prevent another DWI. If you use the information, you won't be back.
