Sub Contractors Reports

Screening Dianne Meda

Reported in December has screened 14 DWI offenders and 1 Magistrate (DV). For the month of January has screened 8 DWI offenders, 2 Magistrate (DV) and 1 out of State (Drug Charges).

JL Norris Counseling

In December 4 clients were referred to her program and in January 3 were referred. They have a total of 22 clients who are being seen weekly. And 8 individuals are in Group Therapy. Everyone is doing well and reporting on time.

Teen Court

Currently have 10 clients. Most clients are second time offenders.

ASPEN

They are having a class still at the Detention Center and Juvenile Detention Center.

CASA

They have increased their visitation rooms from 2 to 5 rooms. They are having victims of Crime on February 20th @ the Bank of America building (3rd floor) from 9 am to 4pm.

Dexter, Hagerman and Lake Arthur Schools

All schools have submitted their reports on time and are doing all Prevention activities as required on the Contract.

Law Enforcement – Sheriff

Chaves County Sheriff's Office had 115 DWI arrests for 2008. Their DWI officer is now Will Seely.

Law Enforcement – State Police

New Mexico State Police had 50 DWI arrests for 2008.

From October thru December they had 30 arrests.

- 15 arrests were first time offenders.
- 7 arrests were second time offenders.
- 1 arrest was a tenth time offender.
- 25 were Males.
- 5 were Females.
- BrAc Average was .13-.14
- BrAc Highest was .21.

Law Enforcement – Roswell

Roswell Police Department had an officer who broke the record for most DWI arrests in 2008. Scott Stevenson had 113 DWI arrests.

Second Quarter Financial Report- Charlotte Andrade.

Fees Collected for the second quarter were \$5,300.00 (Screening) and \$15,789.00 (Probation). Total for fees collected \$21,089.000.

Expenditure report spent was \$9,999.99.

Distribution received for the second quarter was \$71,261.64. For FY09 received up to date is \$138,090.60.

Total expenditures spent up to date are \$103,172.13. The balance is \$34,918.77 and that will change when the DWI officers salary will be journal entry.

DFA/LDWI FY-10 Application is due by the end of February. Charlotte and Mary Lou are working on it. They are rewriting the whole application. And still need letters of support from the community.
